
NON-SPECIFIC CERTIFICATION:

- ISO 17021-1
- Ensures the company's ability to structure itself and managing resources and internal processes in order to meet the customers needs

GDPR vs ISO 27001

Articles	Description	Paragraph	Description
Art. 1 (1)	This Regulation lays down the rules to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and to the free movement of personal data.	§ 1	This standard is applicable to all types of organisations. This International Standard specifies the requirements to establish, implementand improve a documented ISMS within a context of risks relating to the overall business of the organization
Art. 4 (1)	'Personal data' means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject')	§ 3.1	"Good": Anything of value to the organization
Art. 24 (1)	the controller shall implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure and be able to demonstrate that the processing is performed in accordance with this Regulation	A.18.1.4	Privacy and protection of personally identificable information: Privacy and protection of personal data identifiable information shall be ensured by relevant legislation and regulation.

- Is a form of «direct insurance» where the direct correspondence of a product or a service with the applicable requirements is verified Trasduction of the GDPR provisions (articles and recitals)



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
