Early retirement without reduction of pension rights

4/ Purpose or purposes of the processing

The processing operations of personal data consist in:

- collecting applications for early retirement without reduction of pension rights in accordance with article 3 of administrative decision ADM-07-21 (see annex 1 to the notification to the DPO);
- assess the compliance of applications received with the eligibility criteria set up in article 4 of administrative decision ADM-07-21;
- publish the list of eligible candidates;
- examination of the applications;
- publication of selected applicants.

The purpose of the above processing operations of personal data is the implementation of OHIM's administrative decision ADM-07-21 aiming at granting early retirement without reduction of pension rights.

No special categories of data in the sense of article 10 of Regulation 45/2001 are processed in this context.

Data are collected by means of a standard application form specifically designed for the purpose of this procedure (see annex 3 to the notification to the DPO).

Data collected are:

- Personal number;
- Identity of the applicant (name, birthdate, email);
- Affectation (department, service, ...);
- Administrative position;
- Career within OHIM and EU institutions;
- Other rights already granted;
- Motivation;
- Information as concern the transfer of pension rights;
- Date and signature.

Data published are:

- Personal number;
- First name;
- Surname.

7/ Information to be given to data subjects

The call for applications contains specific provisions as concerns data protection, in compliance with article 11 of Regulation 45/2001 (see annex 2 to the notification to the DPO).

8/ Procedures to grant rights of data subjects(*rights of access, to rectify, to block, to erase, to object*)

Data subjects are to submit a written request to the Controller via a functional mailbox.

9/ Automated / Manual processing operation

Applications are to be submitted either by email or by post mail.

The evaluation processes are manual.

Lists are published only on OHIM's intranet (Insite).

10/ Storage media of data

Email applications are stored in outlook folders with restricted access to the people in charge of the procedure within HRD's Personnel Administration Sector.

Paper applications are stored in locked cupboard in a locked office.
