Amazon highlighted a potential tension between regulation and innovation as felt by small and big companies. Amazon expressed concerns regarding recent proposals to have a tiered approach to GDPR obligations. Amazon would welcome amendments to GDPR to facilitate AI training, simplify reporting obligations and DPIA lists. The EDPS highlighted that there will likely be a request for a joint opinion of the EDPS and the EDPB. ▪ Digital Fairness Act and related privacy implications: Amazon stressed potential overlap with GDPR and DSA (e.g., protection of minors, dark patterns, advertising and personalisation) and the need for guidelines and standards to implement legal requirements. The EDPS took note of the information provided. ▪ Joint COM-EDPB Guidelines on the interplay between the Digital Markets Act (DMA) and the GDPR, currently under public consultation. Amazon expressed concerns with the interpretations developed under Articles 6(9) and (10) GDPR, which they believe could expose individuals to risks. Amazon will contribute to the public consultation. The EDPS took note of the information provided. ▪ Concerning Amazon Web Services' European Sovereign Cloud initiative, Amazon shared its goals of ensuring data residency and allowing customers to have more control about where data flows. It will include all AWS cloud services, from storage to AI and confidential computing. The EDPS took note of the information provided.
