

# DATA TAKES FLIGHT

NAVIGATING PRIVACY  
AT THE AIRPORT



## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

### EVENT VENUE

The event “Data takes flight: Navigating privacy at the airport” takes place at the premises of the European Parliament. The Zweig building, where the conference will be hosted, is located at [Ardennestraat, 1000 Brussel](#). The room Agora is directly behind the main entrance.

### PARTICIPATION

The event will take place in a hybrid format, with participation possible both in-person and online, on the 12<sup>th</sup> of February from 14:00 to 17:00. The accreditation period is from 13:30 until 14:00. The event is free of charge and the registration is mandatory.

### ACCESS

The security measures of the European Parliament will apply to all participants. Please note that it will not be possible to issue registrations on the spot.

1) Arrival between 13:00 and 14:00

Arrive at the Zweig building on Ardennestraat, 1000 Brussels, Belgium. We recommend using public transport (train, or metro lines 1 and 5 to Schuman or 2 and 6 to Troon), bicycle or electric scooter.

2) Bring your identification document or passport

For potential security checks as well as for receiving your participants badge, please have a valid identification document or passport at hand.



### 3) Security check

Participants who do not have a badge allowing them access to the European Parliament will have to undergo security checks by the European Parliament security.

## ONLINE PARTICIPATION

The event will be web-streamed via a dedicated WebEx platform (you will receive the link a few days prior to the event). Please note that active participation of online attendees is not foreseen. If you join via WebEx, you should keep your microphone and camera turned off at all times. Any inappropriate behaviour will result in immediate expulsion from the event.

## HOW TO PLACE A QUESTION

In-person: You can ask a question by raising your hand and waiting for one of the organisers to provide you with a microphone. Please be brief and hand the microphone back to the organiser after posing your question.

Online: you can pose a question by sending it to the chat of the WebEx meeting.

## Wi-Fi

To connect to the Wi-Fi select the EP-VISITORS Wi-Fi network on your device. Read the Terms of Use until the end and press Accept.

## VIDEO RECORDINGS AND PHOTOGRAPHY

The conference will be recorded, and recordings will be published on the [EDPS website](#) after the event. Only speakers and active participants will be recorded.
