<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Meeting topics 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The meeting was requested by Meta to present their company’s latest developments and discuss recent EU regulatory matters in the field of data protection and artificial intelligence. ▪ Meta highlighted the company's continuous investment in generative AI—including its models and Meta AI—to deliver more useful, personalised, and creative experiences to users across its platforms and wearable devices (e.g. Meta smart glasses)." ▪ Meta presented their “AI for Compliance” efforts which aim to enhance their internal work and processes, without replacing the human intervention. ▪ Meta welcomes and looks with interest to the Digital Omnibus, and supports having more simplification in the European digital legislations. The EDPS referred to the related EDPB-EDPS Joint Opinion from 10 February 2026 when presenting its view on the Digital Omnibus. ▪ Meta expressed their concerns in relation to some aspects of the EDPB's Guidelines 3/2025 on the interplay between the DSA and the GDPR, such as the EDPB’s interpretation of Article 22 GDPR which, according to Meta, would undermine the safety and integrity of online platforms.
