Subject: Your request for review of EDPS decision of 24 June 2020 on joint cases [REDACTED]

Dear Ms König,

I am writing to you regarding your letter of 22 July 2020 enclosing your request for review of the EDPS Decision of 24 June 2020 on the complaints submitted to the European Data Protection Supervisor (the EDPS) on 19, 26 and 28 October, and 5 December 2019 ([REDACTED]).

We have carefully examined the new factual evidence and legal arguments put forward in your request, as well as the related comments submitted by the complainants.¹ Given that the Single Resolution Board and the complainants have provided new and substantial elements that require a thorough analysis, the EDPS has decided to re-examine his decision in the light of these elements.

The EDPS will thus issue a revised decision, which will be communicated to both the Single Resolution Board and the complainants. The revised decision will replace the decision of 24 June 2020 and both parties may challenge this new decision before the Court of Justice of the European Union in accordance with Article 263 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.²
