Dear EPSO colleagues, dear [REDACTED]

Allow me to intervene: as my colleague [REDACTED] said we will need in our revised decision to take account of the *Pankki S* ruling (C-579/21) and therefore recognise that access to the log-files should be granted.

We are ready to discuss about the above position and get your views in written form or orally but we also need to proceed to adoption of the revised decision. Taking into account the time passed, and the need to reply to the request for review data subject (who has also brought us to Court to annul the original decision of which he requests a review) we will wait until Thursday 26/10 for your comments, past which we will proceed to adopt swiftly a revised decision drawing the consequences from the *Pankki S* ruling as recognising rights of access to log-files in situations like the one of the complainant in the present case. We can be available to meet and hear your views at a meeting on Tuesday 24/10 from 9:30 to 11:00 or at other suitable moments before Thursday 26/10.
