Subject: Closure of DBN case files

As announced in the 50th and 51st DPO meetings (14 June 2022 and 6th December 2022 respectively), the EDPS is proceeding to an exceptional closure of files where there seems to be no current need for detailed feedback or intervention from our side (e.g. common cases, cases where measures to avoid similar breaches have been taken).

Based on this, I inform you that we have closed the cases associated to the following data breach notifications:

Case file number	Notification date

Please also note that the closure of a data breach notification case only refers to the fact no further actions from the EDPS are expected with the information available to it (as regards the controller's obligations stemming from articles 34 and 35 of Reg. (EU) 2018/1725). This is without prejudice to any follow up or other actions the EDPS might undertake in the future with regard to the supervision of the European Ombudsman. In particular, the closure of the case does not exclude:

- any references to that data breach and to any action taken by the European Ombudsman being made in other cases (for instance in the context of an investigation or a complaint of a data subject);
- re opening the closed case if additional information would become available at any moment.

Please inform the internal controllers and update your DBN registry accordingly.
