
Dear Mr Leijtens,

Following the investigation into Frontex transmissions of personal data to Europol (EDPS case 2023-0537) opened pursuant to Articles 57(1)(f) and 58(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2018/17251 (the 'Regulation'), the EDPS has adopted a decision addressed to Frontex, which is enclosed with this letter.

In the decision, the EDPS has taken due account of the written submissions made by Frontex and Europol in the course of these proceedings. The decision sets out findings of infringements and corrective measures under Article 58(2)(b) of the Regulation that the EDPS considers necessary, appropriate and proportionate.

The EDPS intends to make public the facts of this investigation, our final decision and the actions that Frontex has taken in response. If any part of the decision should, in your opinion, be regarded as confidential and not published, please indicate this clearly and provide reasons by 19 December 2024, so that those parts can be dealt with accordingly and redacted where appropriate.
